IV. Motion to Approve 2025-2026 Year to Date Financials

Notes on Financials:

- Boosters distributed \$71,000 so far this school year. \$100,000 had been budgeted.
- Several of the coaches are working on utilizing their budgets now before the end of the school year.
- Some of the sports have incentive funds listed in their budgets - this is the where the credit is shown for concessions volunteering.

V. Old Business

1) Fireworks Booth – June 29th to July 4th this year

- A spreadsheet has been sent out to all the coaches to sign-up for their time slots.
- Once this is complete, it will be pushed out via Sign-Up.com and will also ask that the link to the sign-up be sent out via Parent Square.
- Wrestling has confirmed that they will be there for set-up again this year.

2) New Wraps and Graphics for the Jag Trailer and Golf Carts

- The wraps for both Boosters Golf Carts and the Jag trailer have been completed. They both turned out great and look really sharp.
- Tablecloths and Pop-Up tents with Boosters logo have also been received.
- The Jag Trailer and the Pop-ups will be used at the fireworks booth this year.
- Pop-Ups will also be used at Visitor Concessions during football season when it is very hot and the sun beats down on the booth and the metal counters.

- 3) GABC Scholarship Updates -
 - 9 Scholarship applications were received. The Committee has selected 8 applicants to receive scholarships.
 - This year a maximum of \$10,000 was budgeted for scholarships, which is an increase from the \$4,500 last year, and the Committee decided to award \$10,000 between the 8 students in several different denominations.
 - The Scholarship application listed a requirement for 8 volunteer hours by the student or parent, however there was not a way to verify fulfillment of this requirement, so it was not enforced. Future years will have this requirement, and we will have a way to track.
 - Scholarships will be presented tomorrow night at Senior Awards night in the MPR.
 - Question - Why scholarship funds can only be used to pay the schools directly and the students cannot receive the funds?
Answer: It is a requirement of the Boosters non-profit status that funds do not go directly to students, but Boosters can pay for things for students.
 - Question - What are the requirements of the Scholarship?
Answer: Requirements were reviewed, and they are also listed on the application and on the Boosters website.

VI. New Business

- 1) Upcoming GABC Board Elections for 2026/27 School Year –
 - Ruth will be the Membership Chair for the upcoming school year.
 - President, Secretary, Concessions Chair and Committee are open positions.
 - President and Secretary Board Positions are finishing their 2-year term this year. Boosters must have 3 Board positions filled to continue.
 - Nomination forms have gone out through ParentSquare
 - In addition to the Board positions, there are many additional volunteers needed to run different programs like concessions, fireworks, crab feed, etc.
 - Help will be needed at CLAW, which will be the last week of July. Last year Membership sales were heavy at CLAW and the last year's total memberships sales were \$14k in comparison to the \$4-5k in previous years.
- 2) 2026-2027 School Year Boosters Budget – Will be very similar to this year's budget and will be presented at the August meeting.
- 3) Girls Tennis Request - Requesting an additional \$1,500 beyond what is currently in the budget to purchase uniforms.

Motion: To approve Girl's Tennis going \$1,500 over their current budget to order uniforms.

VII. Open Forum

- 1) Discussion on having more communication between Boosters and Parents for each sport. Would like to look into if Boosters can be added to the GroupMe or whatever platform each sport is using.

- 2) Question regarding Date of Crab Feed for 2027?
Answer: March 20, 2027, which is the Saturday when Spring Break starts. Location will be at same hall on Oakdale Road.
- 3) Question regarding how many hours each sport is required to contribute for Fireworks Booth?
Answer: Depends on the size of the team and how many levels they have.
